Trustees Board: Who are they and what do they do?

The Trustee Ministry manages the material possessions and oversees the financial matters of the church with spiritual sensitivity. The church's physical property, financial obligations and all other assets are the responsibility of the Trustee Ministry. Trustees enable the execution of God's mission through stewardship and individual spiritual gifts. Acting as one body, the Trustees provide direction, leadership and facilities to help further God's word.

The Second Baptist Church Trustee Board is charged with stewardship of all the resources that God has blessed the SBC Church Family with (the Church, Parsonage and the Community Center).

In fulfilling this solemn responsibility, the Trustee board follows a set of Guiding Principles. Some of those principles are listed below:

Spiritual Sensitivity: They have a love for the Lord and consequently the church body. They will be sensitive to its needs and will administer their responsibilities in a manner that provides a robust and fruitful worship environment.

The Importance of using your Duplex Envelopes

Member #:

- When you become a member of Second Baptist Church (SBC), you are assigned a member number. This number is used by the Church Treasury Department to keep an account of all offerings to the church for by that member.
- The Treasury Department creates a Tax Document at the end of each year based on the funds offered in these envelopes. If you don't use the duplex envelope assigned to you when you make donations, the Treasury Department cannot count it in the Tax Document prepared for you. This means for tax purposes, you don't get credit for it. If you want to get credit for all offerings, they must be included in your duplex. If you forget your duplex, extra envelopes are kept in the last pew. Just remember to write your member number and name on the envelope.
- The Treasury Department is responsible for keeping accurate records by law. Your duplex envelopes are used for this purpose.

Envelope Date:

- The members of SBC do a great job in meeting the financial needs of the church and understand the importance of continuing contribution, even if a Sunday is missed. Please note if you miss a Sunday, it is ok to include the missed contribution in your next weeks envelope. It is **not** necessary to turn in missed envelopes.

Additional Lines:

- Additional lines are available for other donations (i.e., Men and Women's Day, Auxiliary & Board Dues, Donations for Haiti, or any other donations not itemized above.

LIFELINE

This program is available to persons who are 65 or older, or persons receiving Social Security Disability whose income is under \$24,432 for a single person and \$29,956 for a married couple. The program enables eligible people to receive a \$225 credit on their electric and/or gas bills.

HOME DELIVERED MEALS

These are available to homebound senior citizens that are not capable of going to a nutrition site for a meal. There is an evaluation process to determine those most in need of these meals. Contact Sharron Schultz Boyle at **Meals on Wheels**, (856) 935-3663.

IN-HOME SERVICES

This is an in-home service program that could provide a certified home health aide to assist with personal care and home maintenance. For further information contact Susan Riley at (856) 878-6022.

ADULT DAYCARE

This program provides medical supervision and care in a group setting for adults that should not be left alone during the day.

NJ EASE (Easy Access Single Entry for Seniors)

A help line for seniors needing information and assistance in accessing a myriad of services available to them.

Older individuals receive information and linkage with appropriate services to meet such needs as transportation, home care, legal assistance, free simple wills, social activities and more.

Photo ID cards are issued to seniors 60 years of age and older. This ID entitles the bearer to various discount privileges with local merchants.

Caregiver Assistance Program (CAP)

In-Home Components:

Provides in-home services to seniors at risk of placement in a nursing facility. CAP is designed to supplement the assistance an individual receives from his/her natural support network of family, friends, and neighbors, as well as from community agencies and volunteer groups. By designing service plans uniquely tailored to the individual, CAP works to enhance the individual's community care options. CAP also strengthens the ability of caregivers to continue in their vital role as primary support providers. Application for CAP is a two-part process. First, financial eligibility is determined; second, functional eligibility is evaluated.
